



# Disinfectant Secondary Labels Guidance

## EPA Recommendations for Labeling Secondary and Service Containers

Although the EPA does not require labels on secondary and service containers, the Department of Transportation (DOT) and Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA) requirements may apply.

EPA recommends that the applicator identify the material in the secondary or service container in the event of a spill to ensure that adequate information regarding the disinfectant can be obtained in case of medical or environmental emergency.
